STOP A BULLY is a registered national charity (#847481306RR0001) and Canada-wide anti-bullying program developed in 2009 by a B.C. teacher. It allows any student, at any school in Canada, who is a victim or witness of bullying and cyberbullying to be able to safely report the details to school officials.

Over the past six years, the *STOP A BULLY* program has helped reduce incidents of bullying and raised awareness and accountability within schools across Canada, while supporting youth dealing with this serious issue. The program has experienced incredible growth in this period and has now grown beyond the capabilities of our small team of dedicated volunteers. **In order to continue operations we seek an established national charity partner to take *Stop A Bully* to new levels of growth for helping Canada youth.**

Program Details:

- National anti-bullying service provided free to all students & schools in Canada
- Member schools in every Province & Territory in Canada
- Approx. 250,000 website visits each year
- Over 150,000 *Stop A Bully* wristbands distributed through *Pink Wrist Campaign*
- Financially secure charity with access to funds
- Ongoing recipient of the significant Google Grant
